



LEAMINGTON STUDIO ARTISTS

LSA is a charity, based at East Lodge in Jephson Gardens, Leamington Spa. It is dedicated to supporting artists and art in the area, aiming to foster and increase public interest, awareness and appreciation of the visual arts.

Information about the LSA will be in the LSA marquee where members will be exhibiting and available to chat about the charity. There are also artists in East Lodge by the Willes Road entrance to Jephson Gardens.

In our marquee, we have several of our members with Jane Archer (vibrant floral watercolours), KJ Matthews (landscape photography and printmaking), Ian Mattingly (landscape watercolours), and Sue Southorn (oils and acrylic abstract landscapes) being joined by new members Sarah Jordan (Peacock and Bear) and Lisa Reiter.

LEAMINGTON IN BLOOM FREE WORKSHOP

Plant a seed activity, animal/insect based arts and crafts, a competition and chat about LIB and its activities. All free to the public.

THE LEAMINGTON SOCIETY

The Leamington Society has been the civic society for Leamington Spa for over 60 years. Our aims are to protect our beautiful town, its buildings, parks and gardens, and to ensure that development is appropriate.

We encourage interest in the town by undertaking appropriate activities, organising talks on local themes and arranging the Awards Ceremony to recognise contributions to our environment. Pop in and learn more about us, or learn more about our fabulous town.

FRIENDS OF LEAMINGTON ART GALLERY & MUSEUM (FLAG)

We will be highlighting Leamington's rich art heritage by providing free trails, allowing families to discover the history of Old Leamington through a mini tour. Our continued work with Leamington Museum and Art Gallery and support for new exhibitions will also be a focus, as will support provided by the Art Gallery and Museum for school projects. We will highlight our funding programme, Adopt an Artwork, for the Madonna della Seggiola. This piece by Laura Cookes, a Warwick artist (active 1866-1891) was donated to Leamington Free Public Library in 1891. After restoration it will be featured in an exhibition of other female artists from the Gallery's collection.

THE ARTS SOCIETY ROYAL LEAMINGTON SPA (TAS RLS)

TAS RLS, a registered charity, is a member society of the Arts Society, a global network of over 90,000 members. We hold illustrated lectures at the Spa Centre covering a whole range of arts-related subjects given by experts in their field. Pop by and take part in our Art Quiz, or some art related activities for the youngsters or young at heart.

COMPTON VERNEY FREE WORKSHOP

A FREE drop-in STEAM activity for all ages. You'll be set the challenge of creating a sailing boat using loose parts, unusual materials and fascinating objects from everyday life. We encourage experimenting and out of the box thinking. Will it float when put to the test? Will it make the journey? Come and join in to find out!

SPA TELEGRAM

We'll be typing people's message requests, either for them to take on the day or for me to deliver. I take message requests, type them up using a 1960s typewriter on a traditionally styled telegram template and deliver them locally by hand if possible or post if further afield.







PLANT MUSIC PERFORMED BY THE TREES AND PLANTS OF JEPHSON GARDENS

Created in collaboration with artists and neurodiverse students of Leamington LAMP.

LAMP Director Timothy Ellis is continuing the development of sensory music with neurodiverse young people. A new area of interest is in bio data sonification - where tiny electronic impulses in living things can be used to influence and control electronic musical instruments, in particular the modular synthesier.

For Art In The Park 2022

we will set up a hybrid jam session between trees and plants in Jephson Gardens with LAMP artists and young people.
